These open positions all offer excellent opportunities for students in healthcare programs to gain valuable experience.



A tree-lined, 44-acre campus in Beaverton is home to the Sisters of St. Mary of Oregon, whose infirmary provides an environment of peace and healing for all the Sisters, especially those who need round-the-clock care. To assist with that care, the Sisters are seeking experienced, hands-on caregivers to join their team of healthcare professionals. **Pay starts between \$11.00 and \$12.25 per hour, depending on experience, and there are annual cost-of-living increases.**

Swing-shift Caregiver – Part-time with Full Benefits

The successful candidate will typically work from 4 to 11 PM, Sunday-Tuesday and 3 to 7 PM on Wednesdays and Thursdays, but some variation is possible, and there will be opportunities to pick up additional shifts.

The compensation package will include full benefits: medical insurance (which covers naturopathy, acupuncture, chiropractic, and massage therapy); choice of PPO or HMO dental insurance; vision insurance; 100% employer-paid life and disability insurance; a free employee assistance program; and generous, 100%-vested employer contributions to a retirement plan that does not require employees to contribute.

Fill-in Caregivers

The successful candidates will have many opportunities to cover shifts for co-workers during both planned and unexpected absences.

Requirements

- A proven track record of reliable attendance and attention to detail
- The ability to lift up to 40 pounds on a regular basis
- The ability to stand and walk for several hours at a time
- The ability to pass a background check
- Hands-on experience assisting with activities of daily living (preferably in an institutional setting)
- The ability to establish respectful rapport with the Sisters and their visitors.
- Since the infirmary is in the cloistered part of the Sisters' Convent, only women can be considered for this position.
